

Becoming a Certified Teacher with Paterson Public Schools Guidance through the Alternate Route

Establishing Eligibility Certificate of Eligibility (CE)

The Certificate of Eligibility (CE) is issued to an individual who has not completed a teacher preparation program but meets the basic requirements for certification, including academic study and applicable test requirements. The CE authorizes an individual to seek and accept employment in New Jersey public schools requiring certification.

Degree Requirement

- A minimum of a bachelor's degree is required from a regionally accredited college/university.



Cumulative GPA Requirement

- New Jersey requires that candidates for certification have a GPA of at least 3.0 graduating on or after September 1, 2016 (2.75 for those graduating before September 1, 2016) in a baccalaureate degree program, higher degree program or a State-approved post baccalaureate certification program with a minimum of 13 semester-hour credits.



Basic Skills Assessment Requirement (choose one)

- All candidates applying for their initial CE must pass a Commissioner-approved test of basic skills (reading, writing and math).
- Scores must be presented directly from Educational Testing Service to the NJ Department of Education.

OR

- Score in the top one-third percentile on the SAT, ACT, or GRE for the year the test was taken. Official score reports must be sent directly from the testing agency



Praxis II Test Requirement

- Applicants for New Jersey licensure in subject teaching fields, early childhood, elementary, middle and high school education must pass the appropriate PRAXIS Subject Assessment.



Physiology and Hygiene Requirement

- This requirement may be completed by choosing one of the following options:
 - 1.) Present evidence of basic military training
 - 2.) Complete a course such as biology, health or nutrition that appears on a regionally accredited 2 or 4-year college/university transcript
 - 3.) Complete an online test. You must have a tracking number and an application on file on NJEDCERT to take this test.

1 I'm certified to teach in another State

Paterson Public Schools extends a warm welcome to out-of-state applicants holding an equivalent teaching certificate. However, such applicants are required to apply for a New Jersey teaching certificate through interstate reciprocity.
