## RPHS Students Connect with Global Leaders, Tackle Issues

Twelve Rosa Parks School of Fine and Performing Arts (RPFS) students took part in the *Academic Enrichment without Borders* curriculum, a global program where students meet global change-makers in nongovernmental humanitarian relief organizations (NGOs) with a chance to engage and embrace worldwide humanitarian causes.



During the six-week program, they interviewed via skype several NGO leaders to discuss societal issues in their countries and create humanitarian solutions. Students spoke to leaders in Bolivia, Nigeria and in Paterson – they also conducted “elevator pitches” for a number of NGO with insightful solutions to address specific global challenges facing local communities.

The dynamic curriculum allowed the students to use such skills as interviewing, public speaking, research, active listening, and teamwork. Upon completing the program, all participating students
